

USS Requirements for Coaching Certification

Level 1

The US Speedskating Level 1 coursework can be taken in an offered USS Coaching Course or as home study with a Mentor coach who will have to be a current certified USS Level 2 or higher coach. Minimum age to start is 17 years of age and can be fully certified with 18.

- Home exam
 - Please submit to USS
- 25 hours of coaching
 - Count starts after processing of your Level 1 application by USS
 - Please submit verification form
- 10 lessons plans
 - o Please submit to USS
- Concussion Awareness Course
 - o This course is free of charge, time commitment approx. 10-30 min
 - o Please submit certification
- <u>ASEP sports safety course</u> or a hands-on First Aid/AED class with Red Cross, American Heart Saver Association, Fire Department
 - Will have to be renewed every two years
 - Please submit current certification
- In-class CPR Certification
 - Hybrid-classes are accepted as well. Coursework is also offered as combination CPR and First Aid/AED
 - o Will have to be renewed every two years
 - Please submit current certification
- Attend a competition at least as assistant coach
 - o Please have verification form signed by meet director
 - Please submit verification form

Level one must be completed within one year of application.

Level 2

The US Speedskating Level 2 coursework can be taken in an offered USS Coaching Course or as home study with a Mentor coach who will have to be a current certified USS Level 2 or higher coach.

- Home exam
 - Please submit to USS
- 75 hours of coaching
 - Count starts after processing of your Level 2 application by USS
 - Please submit verification form
- 10 lessons plans
 - Please submit to USS
- <u>ASEP sports safety course</u> or a hands-on First Aid/AED class with Red Cross, American Heart Saver Association, Fire Department
 - Will have to be renewed every two years
 - Please submit current certification
- In-class CPR Certification
 - Hybrid-classes are accepted as well. Coursework is also offered as combination CPR and First Aid/AED
 - Will have to be renewed every two years
 - Please submit current certification
- Camp attendance (two or more days) with a current USS certified coach in attendance

Level 2 must be completed within two years of application.

Level 3

This course is only offered as seminar style course. Partaking in the complete seminar is mandatory to be considered for certification. Seminars are usually offered on a two year cycle unless demand exceeds availability.

- Mandatory seminar
- Practical one year
 - Count starts after completion of seminar
- Submit comprehensive one year training plan, including periodization, training load, monitoring tools for progression and explanation
- <u>ASEP sports safety course</u> or a hands-on First Aid/AED class with Red Cross, American Heart Saver Association, Fire Department
 - Will have to be renewed every two years
 - o Please submit current certification
- In-class CPR Certification
 - Hybrid-classes are accepted as well. Coursework is also offered as combination CPR and First Aid/AED
 - o Will have to be renewed every two years
 - Please submit current certification
- Practical evaluation completed
 - Please send verification to USS
- Coach 4 competitions
 - Please send verification to USS
- Camp attendance (two or more days) with a current USS certified coach in attendance

- Weight training evaluation by a certified strength and conditioning coach
 - Please send verification to USS

All Level 3 documents must be submitted within the two year time frame to be considered.

All coaching licenses are valid for up to 3 years and expire in the respective year on 6/30. To renew/extend an existing coaching license please complete a CE credit through the Gatorade Science website, submit proof of other continued education (i.e. university coursework, sports performance seminar), take part in a USS coaching clinic as presenter or move up to the next coaching level.
